<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>In English this term, we are looking at fairytales with the text Blackberry Blue. The children will be developing their creative writing skills, using description and a range of punctuation to write their own fairytale.</p> <p>In the final half term, we will be writing our own book of Lost Adventures and studying a play by Shakespeare.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>The Year 5s will be covering shape, decimals, position and direction and volume for the next few months. We are currently on our shape unit, exploring angles and 3D shapes.</p> <p>Before SATs the Year 6s will be covering shape and algebra and brushing up on their fluency skills. After SATs, until the end of the year, we will be covering skills that the children are less confident in and will start looking at some trickier concepts ready for Year 7.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>This term in history the children will be looking at the Benin society and the history of African countries.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>This term in geography, the children will be exploring the Alpine Region. They will learn about trade, tourism and why people should visit the Alps. The children will also learn about the formation of the Alps and how it has changed over time.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>In science this term we will first be looking at Earth and space before moving on to revisiting our knowledge of materials.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art/DT</u></p> <p>In art this half term, we will be exploring how artists use light, form and colour to create immersive environments.</p> <p>The children will be ending the year with a DT unit, focusing on textiles and joining different shapes.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>French</u></p> <p>The children will be continuing their French learning this term with Mrs Meek.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Our computing units for this term are 3D modelling and we will revisit our programming skills.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE/Physical Development</u></p> <p>In the run up to Sports Day we will be practicing our athletics skills.</p> <p>We will be learning the skills needed to play tennis in the final half term of the year.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE/Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <p>PSHE this term will focus on health and wellbeing. We will look at the importance of mental health, grief and the impact of being online.</p>
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RE/Religious Education

This half term our RE focus is Sacred Texts, looking in particular at gospels and how they are used to help guide people in what to do.

After half term we will finish the year by looking at Christianity and Humanism. We will explore key values, similarities and differences and how we can help make the world a better place.

Home learning

The children again will be receiving weekly spellings and one to two pieces of home learning per week. We also would encourage daily reading for the children. Having an adult listen to the children read out loud will support the children enormously in their learning and asking the children questions that help deepen their understanding of the text will support their growth further.
