Class 1 – Reception. PE Days: Monday and Friday. NO Forest School

This week in Reception we have been continuing to learn about the continents of the World focusing on Antarctica and Australasia. We have learnt facts and watched videos then guided our beebots from these continents around the world on a World map. We also write sentences about the facts we remembered. We have also given our partners instructions to help them find hidden model pirates in our outside area. We have had fun in our role play area serving ice creams and cupcakes in the hot weather and have done lots of water play fun to keep us cool. We have also started illustrating our pirate stories which the children are excited to share with you next week.

Class 3 – Year Two & Three. PE Days: Monday and Thursday.

This week, Class 3 have coped tremendously well in spite of the heat! We have been finishing off our units of work and remembering just how much we have learnt over the term. The children looked at the nutritional value of sandwiches - including some tasting - ready to make our own next week. In English, we had a virtual tour of Tower Bridge and have been writing sentences to explain how steam was generated and used to power the lifting mechanism. We learnt some new technical vocabulary, so you may be tested to answer what a bascule is! I hope you have a cool and restful weekend before our final week.

Class 4 – Year Four & Five. PE Days: Monday and Friday.

Class 4 have done so well to brave the hot weather again this week. On Thursday, we enjoyed a fabulous visit to Loddiswell Station, where the children were treated to a grand tour of the grounds. We explored the old platform tracks, the ticket office, the goods area and the signal box, learning how the station has changed over time. One of the most fascinating parts of the trip was discovering how, since its closure 60 years ago, the whole site has been gradually reclaimed by wildlife. The children loved spotting plants, insects and signs of nature taking over the old railway spaces. We finished the trip with a well-earned ice lolly — the perfect end to a brilliant day out.

Class 5 – Year Six. PE Day: Wednesday and Friday. Thursday AM Forest School

Year 6 had a fantastic time at Singing Paddles on Tuesday morning. We were so lucky with the beautiful weather and the children all worked brilliantly as a team to paddle up and down the estuary. Some children then attended the local church on Tuesday afternoon to have a go at bell ringing. It was a great experience and they came back with lots of new knowledge. We finished off our Shoe Box Project in English and it has been so lovely to see the children create a collection of work that is personal to them. Super week everyone, well done!
